

Getting there

By train: Upfield Line to Gowrie Station, exit eastbound, five minute walk to Jukes Road or catch connecting bus.

By bus: route 530 (Cambellfield) departing every 30 minutes from Sydney Road. Exit at Minona St /Jukes Rd Fawkner intersection.

By bicycle

- Option One: Take the Upfield bike track northbound, turn right at Jukes Rd/Gowrie Station.
- Option Two: Take a leisurely ride northbound along the Merri Creek bike track from Coburg Lake. Turn left at Jukes Road exit approx 20 mins from Coburg Lake.

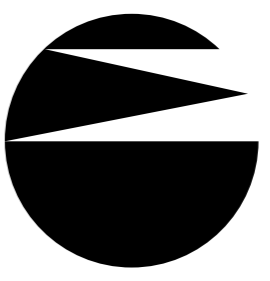
